10:00 Transition to Community Snack: *Eating together helps develop community and we learn valuable skills including setting & clearing our places, staying seated while eating, pouring drinks and enjoying time together!*

10:30 Toddler Gathering: *Our Gathering is our relaxed group time where we gather to enjoy sitting together, practicing silence & mindfulness, singing songs, and talking about our day.*

10:45 Outside Time: *Lots of opportunities for unstructured open-ended play, gross motor activities and social interaction.*
